



## KCA Dress Code

Kingdom Christian Academy's dress codes consist of the following for all grades.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Knit Polo/Oxford/Turtleneck Shirts with School Logo (See Below for Academy approved colors)</li><li>• Khaki Pants/Short Pants/Cargo Shorts (navy blue or khaki colors only)</li><li>• Black shoes/sneakers/boots</li><li>• White/Black/Blue or Tan Socks</li><li>• Black Belt which must be visible when shirts are tucked in</li><li>• Navy Blue, Gray, Burgundy, or White Sweaters with School Logo</li><li>• Navy Blue, Gray, or Burgundy Fleece Vest or Jacket with School Logo</li><li>• Navy Blue, Burgundy, or Black Blazer</li><li>• Navy or Gray Sweat Pants and Shirts with School Logo</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Knit Polo/Oxford/Turtleneck Shirts with School Logo (See Below for Academy approved colors)</li><li>• Khaki Pants/Capris/Cargo Shorts /Skirts/Jumpers/Skorts (navy blue or khaki colors only)</li><li>• Black closed toe shoes /sneakers/boots</li><li>• White/Black/Blue or Tan Socks, Tights, Leggings and Stockings</li><li>• Navy Blue, Gray, Burgundy, or White Sweaters with School Logo</li><li>• Navy Blue, Gray, or Burgundy Fleece Vest or Jacket with School Logo</li><li>• Navy Blue, Burgundy, or Black Blazer</li><li>• Navy or Gray Sweat Pants and Shirts with School Logo</li></ul>

Shoes and socks must be worn at all times during school hours. Uniforms must be neat, clean and appropriately fitted. Rolled up shirts-sleeves, pants and/or skirts are not acceptable.

Skirt, jumpers, skorts, and safari shorts length are to be to the top of the knees or longer. Uniforms too baggy and hanging off the waistline are not acceptable. Uniforms too short, too tight or too baggy will result in parents being called to either bring in appropriate fitting clothing or to retrieve the students from the school premises.

Students who report to school out of KCA's dress code will receive an infraction notice. If a student receives 3 infractions, parents may be contacted to either bring in school approved clothing or to retrieve the student from school premises, based on the severity of the infraction.

Boys may not wear EARRINGS ON SCHOOL PREMISES. Boys' belts must be visible when shirts are tucked in.

Sweat Pants and Sweat Shirts are only permitted on designated days, such as Physical Education/Gym Day, Earth Day, and/or Field Day.

Hats and headgear of any style and type are not to be worn in the school building at any time. Black shoes (no open-toed shoes or sandals) or all black sneakers or boots are to be worn at all times. Color-coordinated socks, tights, leggings or stockings are to be worn with uniforms as well.

Coats or jackets are not permitted to be worn in class or in the hallways. Only the approved navy blue, gray, burgundy or white sweaters and fleece vests/jackets with the school logo may be worn as needed.

Shirts that are worn under the school shirt must be the approved uniform color

**School Approved Colors for Shirts are Navy Blue, White, Gray, Yellow, and Burgundy.**
